





### Session on Nutrition and its effects on Mental Health.




### Food Distribution at David Sassoon Home, Matunga

The celebration concluded with the lighting of fireworks donated to the children, filling the atmosphere with happiness and bringing bright smiles to their faces.




### Donation of Smart board, ZP school, Karjankhol

NeoSmile Foundation was proud to contribute to this important milestone, and the school expressed its heartfelt appreciation for the initiative and its positive impact on students' education.





### Donation of Desktops at Kanya Vidyalaya, Chakan, Pune

The initiative benefited more than 600 students, who expressed their appreciation for the support and the new opportunities for learning made possible through this contribution.





### Donation of Desktops at People's Mobile Hospital, Worli, Mumbai

Among the beneficiaries, St. Stephen School, which has played a crucial role in enhancing learning for students with hearing impairments, which depends primarily on visual instruction.

The introduction of visual digital learning enabled students to better understand letters, songs, and classroom concepts that are otherwise difficult to communicate through sound alone.

Interactive lessons helped improve comprehension, participation, and confidence among children.

NeoSmile Foundation was delighted to witness students actively engaging with every lesson through the use of this equipment. This thoughtful contribution created a meaningful and lasting impact on their overall learning experience.
